

Davis Arts Center Firing Services: Price Sheet

Kiln Firing Options

Cone 06 - Low-Fire Glaze Firing **or** Bisque Firing Mid-Range/High-Fire Clay

Cone 04 - Bisque Firing Low-Fire Clay

Cone 6 - Mid-Range Glaze Firing

Note: All firings are oxidation firings done in electric kilns.

Timing

We will notify you when your piece is ready to pick-up. The kilns are operated by one of our teaching artists, so the turn-around time on firing may vary depending on the week, but we always do our best to fire pieces as soon as possible.

Pricing For Individual Pieces

Pricing is determined by volume (in cubic inches) of the piece, each piece is measured as if it were a rectangular box.

Length x Width x Height x \$0.01 = Price per piece.

Minimum charge for first piece: \$2.00

Minimum charge for each additional piece: \$0.50

Full 9.9 Cubic Foot Kiln Rental - Opening: 28 in. x 28 in., Interior Height: 27 in.

Cone 06-04 - \$25 + \$50/hr Loading and Unloading

Cone 03-6 - \$35 + \$50/hr Loading and Unloading

Full 7 Cubic Foot Kiln Rental - Opening: 23 in. x 23 in., Interior Height: 27 in.

Cone 06-04 - \$20 + \$50/hr Loading and Unloading

Cone 03-6 - \$30 + \$50/hr Loading and Unloading

Damage To Kiln Shelves

If damage occurs to the kiln shelves due to a piece, dripping, running, melting, or exploding you will be charged \$3 dollars per piece or \$20 if the shelf is rendered completely unusable and needs to be

discarded. If you are not sure of whether your piece will run or not, please bring a clay coaster for your piece or purchase one from us.

Things To Keep In Mind

Payment is required at time of pick-up.

Pieces should be fully dried before dropping off.

We do not do single-firing, we will not fire greenware that has glaze on it. If your piece has underglaze, please state that on the dropoff sheet.

No packing materials are allowed to be left behind, Please take all packing materials with you at drop-off.

No packing materials are provided at pick-up, please bring your own.

You will need to provide your own stilts if you would like for your pieces to be fired on them, only low-fire pieces can be stilted.

Please clean your bottoms, even a small amount of glaze on the bottom can cause your piece to fuse with the shelf, damaging both our shelf and the piece. We will clean off any glaze we find, however we will add a \$0.50 additional charge to any piece that needs to be cleaned.

Solid clay pieces will not be fired, sculptural pieces need to be hollowed out and require a ventilation hole.

Fired pieces must be picked up within 14 days of being fired or they will be tossed.

Ceramic pieces are delicate and may be damaged during the firing process, we are not responsible for any damage that may occur to your piece.
